We have now received the final report from OFSTED following our inspection on the 4th and 5th November; a copy of which is on our website.

We are very pleased to tell you that we were awarded 'Good' in all areas and if you take time to read the report it is a true reflection of the school your child attends. Ofsted identified that 'The school is led and managed well. The recently appointed joint headteachers have a clear vision and a strong ambition for the school and a passion to succeed' where 'the pupils are proud of their school'.

They also highlighted the way the school promotes pupils' personal growth through the curriculum and its long established values, developing pupils who are keen to do their best, take responsibility; preparing them to be confident, happy, and motivated life-long learners. They also commented on the broad range of opportunities both curricular and extra-curricular that are on offer to all pupils.

However, this doesn't diminish our desire to achieve outstanding in our next report.

The report reflects the huge amount of work that has taken place to move the school forwards. What should be pleasing for everyone involved with the school is that the report recognises the rapid progress we have made in the last year and the positive impact that this has had on our pupils.
